School	Comment
Acceleration East	I am concerned that students at home are not receiving instruction, but still completing assignments with 100% accuracy. In my mind, this is an obvious sign of cheating. As a teacher, how can I assess students at home at the same level as those in the classroom? Essentially those students at home can earn perfect grades without any accountability. I also wonder how I can be fairly observed and rated when my students are not in class for me to teach.
Apopka	At the beginning of the year, they stated no more online learning. It was either face to face or you joined OCVS. Now the district comes out and says it's fine if you're home as long as you are emailing your teacher and they give you work online? That defeats the purpose. I'm constantly having to keep up with 165 students and whether or not they are quarantined or home sick of just out for personal reasons. It's too much.
Apopka High School	By the superintendent's vague message to parents who are demanding way more than any teacher can provide
Apopka High School	I will not provide additional classroom materials without additional pay.
Apopka Middle	My main concern is the custodial staff also has Covid, so our classroom tables are not disinfected, and the rooms not cleaned daily because there are not enough people to do them. I feel like a sitting duck just waiting until it's my turn to get the virus. Also, we only have cloth masks to give to students and they are too big for their faces.
Avalon Middle School	My admin is good, as they can be in this "System" were money talks and safety walks
Bay Meadows Elementary	Admin was very clear that this was not required and what the procedure was.
Boone	Currently quarantined, told my quarantine is over today but I am still positive as of today. Told to put in sick time for next 2 days.
Boone	Fully vaccinated March 2021. COVID September 2021 and January 2022. Medical issues from first COVID illness

	resulted in additional PTO not covered by district and cardiology work up with my out of pocket being in excess of \$1000.
Bridgewater Middle School	I feel our school, administrators and teachers do a good job making everyone feel safe. But I don't think we have enough custodial staff to keep the school truly clean.
Brookshire	I am currently sick at home with Covid. My class has not been notified that there are Covid cases in the classroom. Last week there were Covid cases in my classroom. One student was there all 4 days and the parent notified me on Sunday evening that her daughter has tested positive for Covid and that entire family has Covid. I was in close contact with the child and the mother every day at dismissal. On Monday, January 10, I tested positive for Covid.
Castleview	Students and staff should wear masks.
Chain of lakes	I have not officially been exposed to covid, but I've had students in the classroom not wearing a mask and they are quarantined with covid. So yes I am being exposed by students without a mask, I'm just protecting myself as best as I can.
Clay Springs	I just truly think that students should have masks on. Okay, they may be more resilient but all the reason they should all have masks on. It's like who cares about the educators.
Colonial	I am concerned about students who are taking advantage of the stay-at-home option if parents are concerned about covid. These generally are students that have not reached out to their teachers in regards to staying on top of their work. My concern is that come the end of a 9 weeks or the semester teachers will be heavily questioned as to why these kids have missing assignments and/or might be failing because the kids chose to stay home and not do work. Teachers have been told previously that they should not have more than 10% of their kids with Ds or fs on a report card and if they do they end up in extra meetings with administration. Who then questions why they are not supporting kids and instead are failing them.
Colonial High	I had a student who told me that she has 3 positive cases in her household and that she is taking care of her family. I reported this and was told because she is asymptomatic that

	<p>she does not have to quarantine, take a test, or have proof of vaccination as per the new OCPS Health and Safety manual that was updated and changed without bargaining as of 1-5-2022 (stated in an email to the nurses, 1-3-2022, but wasn't posted until 1-5-2022). Thank goodness the parent has a conscience and kept student home until she can be tested. This is UNACCEPTABLE. I want to speak to OCPS about this!</p>
Colonial High School	<p>We have not been told to do something like this yet, but I wouldn't be surprised if they ask us in the near future due to the EXTREME lack of attendance.</p>
Curriculum Services	<p>I contracted Covid but it wasn't through school. I quarantined for 10 days but five of them were vacation days for Thanksgiving. I contacted the health department and my schools. I did not have contact with any of my students so that was not an issue</p>
Cypress Creek	<p>No - but parents expect it</p>
Cypress Creek High	<p>Front office called me to inform a student in my class tested positive for covid and had to go home. I wrote the student a pass. Student was not wearing a mask. Also cleaning staff walk around with mask hanging off face and one of them coughing with mask off while in restroom areas.</p>
Cypress Creek High School	<p>The dashboard is too confusing. We get calls that our school has positive cases associated with the school but no exact number is provided for the community and staff to make decisions as to how bad it really is.</p>
Cypress Creek HS	<p>35-40</p>
Dillard Street	<p>I believe the bigger health concern is forcing this kids to be on grade level when we are struggling to keep them healthy. Ocps and admin is acting as if this was a normal year and placing so many thing on the teachers and students. Mental health of our staff and students is being over looked.</p>
Discovery Middle School	<p>I am the Latinos in Action teacher at my school. My students tutor once per week at the elementary school. Some elementary school students contracted COVID, but I was not informed of this. Students, as well as myself, are being pressured to continue tutoring, despite potentially unsafe conditions. We're not being offered the option of staying behind.</p>

Dr Phillips	No soap in student bathrooms, no masks to provide on campus
Dream Lake	It was early in the year and my Resource classes had not yet started!
East Lake Elementary	Administration was clear that work was to be left for students to complete at home by week. No livestream lessons were required at all.
East Learning Community & 2 schools	I have had different experiences at different work sites. Some are more supportive and happy to provide me anything I need, add me to call lists. Another site it is more difficult. I have less information and am less sure that if a student I worked with was to become ill I would be contacted.
Eccleston	I do not feel like my classrooms are being properly cleaned and sanitized. I've come in every day since October to find tile floors not mopped, desks not wiped, and my bathroom sink not cleaned.
Edgewater	I have a higher number of students, Lack of mask mandates is scary. Not one of my unvaccinated students wear masks. Lack of appropriate health protocols is scary.
Edgewater ESE Admin Building	At our worksite: we have not been provided KN-95 masks this year or any masks this year. We also did. It receive the COVID tests that were distributed to other worksites.
Edgewater High School	To say there's a lag between the district's dashboard and Edgewater High School's actual numbers would be a gross understatement. I've had several students contact me indicating they had Covid, but have not received one email indicating I

	came into contact. Janitors are not sanitizing rooms as they did last year, and we have to beg to get masks.
Elementary	We do not need to provide video but we do need to have everything that we teach virtual for any students who are sick or are being "cautious". All assignments must be accessible on Canvas and that's hard for early elementary. We were told not to give tests and make them up when they return but that makes it difficult because the class has already moved on and is learning new content.
Forsyth Woods	Have been asked to provide paper work for quarantined students, then they never come to pick it up.
Forsyth Woods Elementary	We are told to provide work packets. This is I overwhelming to keep up with.
Frangus	Our work is not online and we are made to provide work for the students whose parents decide to keep them home.
Frangus Elementary	When we are notified it is often two weeks later, so it's too late to do anything.
Freedom high	The school is doing a good job with making sure teachers know that they are to continue teaching and not do distance learning. Kids out have to follow assignments on canvas and make up tests and quizzes when back
Freedom High School	Our principal informed students they could stay home, but we have not been pressured to resume launched style lessons
Freedom HS	I've been sick for a month, I assume I got Covid, but did not test in time.
Freedom Middle	I have been contacted by admin asking if I've been vaccinated which I assume means I was exposed. I was never contacted by the DOH even though I sit in small groups, as required by the district, with these students while they either have no mask or are improperly wearing one. I have only been contacted once but will have students return from being absent and tell me they had COVID. I do not keep count for my mental health.
Glenridge	Together with the union, the district made unvaccinated employees pariahs. We deserve to stay home when we have COVID and not have to use our leave.
Glenridge Middle School	I don't know officially if I contracted COVID at school, but we wear masks, don't really go

	anywhere, and the only place that I'm around non-maskers consistently is at school.
Horizon High School	Horizon High, under the leadership of (newly retired) Principal Laura Beusse, has done an outstanding job of doing everything allowed under district and state regs to keep teachers and students safe. OCPS and the state have failed us on every level.
Horizon West middle	I had covid as of 12/28 and symptoms lasting over 10 days. Ocps had my 5 paid days counting over winter break. I had to use 5 sick days, including one for the planning day even though I worked from home to set my class up for the week. The district should pay 5 sick days as the CDC still recommends 10 days quarantine if you have symptoms. My sub days were put into Kelley under the CARES act. Why? To be clear my issue is with the district, not school based admin.
Horizon West Middle	My room is not being sanitized or cleaned. Only trash is removed from the room.
Horizon West Middle	Overall, I believe my principal cares and wants the school to be safe. I think the district has its hands tied by the governor regarding masks that should be required of students. The district hasn't provided things it could, like masks to students and faculty, as well as hand sanitizer.
Hospital Homebound	Admin is trying. Their hands are tied and going into homes is so unsafe right now!!
Hospital Homebound	I don't think there's any consistency between schools and parents and community etc.
Hospital Homebound	No pressure from admin, but by the parent, so I taught virtually while on Covid TDY.
Howard	I'm choosing to live stream so students don't feel completely lost when they come back.
Hunter's Creek Middle School	Our principal is desperately trying to get adequate custodial staff and the district isn't helping at all. The only cleaning happening in our classrooms is the trash being emptied. NO SANITATION.
Jones	My room has not been cleaned in months.
Lake Nona High	It's been a great year. Admin has been great. Common sense, healthy living and vaccines. That's all you need
Lake Nona High	Though I am not being pressured to provide audio and video, I am being "strongly encouraged" by admins and my team lead to heavily monitor student status on whether they were out sick or just out due to concern.

	This makes it awkward when I am not even supposed to be asking students whether they had COVID or not. As well, we are encouraged to penalize students who aren't working at pace from home, which again I am unsure if it is due to COVID or actual task avoidance.
Lake Nona High	We are told that we should consider this as a possible option for students who choose to learn from home, but we are not mandated to do this. Quite a number of parents at the first week or so felt that their child had an excused, extra time to make up assignments if they chose to learn from home. I've spent 4-6 hours a week emphasizing administration's position that they must stay on top of their assignments daily.
Lake Nona MS	Students are testing positive in my classroom who sit less than 3 feet from my desk and I have not been contacted regarding contact tracing by the school or DOH.
Lake Nona Middle School	We split a class among 3 teachers last week so I do not know if that will be reported for compensation.
Lake Weston Elementary	I'm waiting to be tested now but I keep being used as a substitute for a teacher who tested positive and I didn't know it. I feel my school just wants warm bodies and that's all they care about. We don't have subs, there's no social distancing with kids, and masks are a joke. I handed them out to all the kids I personally see. We sit at a back table for interventions and there's no space between the students and myself.
Lancaster Elementary	Multiple emails suggested that we provide work through Canvas.
LCES	The COVID funds starting January 1st are not for all employees when they get Covid. Vaccines are not mandated therefore the COVID funds should be for all employees.
Lovell elementary	My administration is not the problem, they are doing as they are told. The health department tracing is not quick enough to properly quarantine people. The school administration hands are tied as they await for the health department to do its job.
McCoy	I actually wish the county would provide a way that we could have digital lessons for quarantined kids. Maybe the team that built the CRMs could provided mini lessons kids

	<p>could view on their devices at home? Catching up all of these quarantined kids is a challenge.</p>
Meadow Woods Elementary	<p>If the students are not using the mask I do not have why pay consequences spending my leave hours when I'm following all the covid protocols. In addition back in August I lost all my leave hours because my coworker went to work with covid.</p> <p>The students are spreading the virus no using the mask. I do not have pressure from administrator but I have to put my class in canvas for those students with covid because it is the instructions.</p>
Memorial Middle School	<p>Our AP Ms. Rodriquez has been great in providing PPE!</p>
MetroWest	<p>While with covid I was told to return to work 5 days after my positive test even when I was still testing positive. I did not go into work as I did not find that to be a responsible decision. I was only paid for covid leave one day which was Monday after winter break and had to use all of my sick leave and a day with no pay while out recovering from covid (I was still testing positive on Wednesday of that same week). I find this both irresponsible from the district and also unfair. My administrators supported my decision to stay home but they could not do anything about the matter.</p>
Metrowest ES	<p>We get calls from my admin about cases but they are not listed properly on dashboard by OCPS. I had a student come to school all day on Thursday and test positive right after school and still have no received a call for his case.</p>
Millennia	<p>An email was sent to teachers stating this was NOT the expectation.</p>
Millennia Gardens	<p>Many of these issues are from the management at the ELC. Principals and APs are doing what they can but it's above them that is the problem. The admin have no support and are many times left to fend for themselves.</p>

Millennia Gardens	There is a continuous disconnect between district and school-for example- at school teachers feel very uncomfortable switching for interventions, etc- however- district directives state to proceed as normal
Millennia Gardens Elementary	We have kids and staff dropping like flies and OCPS wants us to continue business as usual with switching students for interventions and doing small group with students with no mask coughing and sneezing in your face and picking their nose and hands in their mouth all over the place. It just adds to the stress of it all.
NLC	My biggest concern is the lack of cleaning/sanitizing at the schools I support. It appears custodians no longer wipe down surfaces with disinfectants. There also appears to be difficulty filling custodian positions and there are announcements fairly often about being short-staffed "so please put your trash outside your door", etc.
Oak Hill Elementary	It's spreading in our schools! Surprised no quarantines have been issued. Teachers come in sick and then test positive. I have to cover a class twice in the am due to sub shortages.
Oak Ridge high	A student emailed me saying they tested positive for covid and they were in my classroom on Monday. I have yet to hear from admin about this particular student and the potential for contamination in my classroom and for other students.
Oak Ridge High School	I know I have been exposed to Covid, although I have not been told by the FLDOH. It is documented in the attendance records for students and it is not hard to figure out when teachers are out if they are out due to Covid. Many teachers are professional and have the courtesy to tell you if they test positive especially if you work together. But I am currently home sick with a respiratory issue and was only able to get a rapid test which was negative because there is a shortage of Covid tests. I know I was exposed to Covid and will be out sick for a few days.
Oakshire ES	I have not heard about any quarantines despite positive cases on campus.
Ocoee	I have not decided to quit or take a leave because the students need face to face

	<p>learning. They are already behind and if I leave that will be one more classroom of 17 students who will fall further behind in their learning. Then they will be sent on to the next grade unprepared.</p>
Ocoee	<p>Our classrooms are not being cleaned. Only trash emptied and maybe restrooms are being cleaned daily (I can't tell because I don't see them being cleaned just told). We're told it's because we don't have a crew leader and only 2 custodians to clean the whole school and they can't get any substitutions to come.</p>
Ocoee Elementary	<p>I was recently informed by administration that a child can have family members positive in their home, but the child can still come to school with or without a mask. That's the issues I am dealing with... Children coming to school when family members are positive; the child not tested to see if he/she is positive; returning to school because he/she is not showing "symptoms." Yet have a house full of people positive for Covid. I am "high risk" and I have really doing all that I can to keep myself safe and my family safe. It's been 2 years and by the grace of God my family and I have not been exposed. Like I said, "by the Grace of God", not because of OCPS procedures. I am also a RN. I see the symptoms everyday around the school and in my class. I send my students to the nurse... they send them back! Students that were confirmed positive and asked to stay home until a certain date per DOH, parents return them 2-3 days early, admin permits it. I feel like a sacrificial lamb for this job. My priority is taking care of my family. So I hang in here just for that purpose, while in the meantime give all that I can to help these precious students to excel and prepare for their future, by setting the foundation for the skills they will need to succeed. I love teaching, but I am not willing to risk my health for it nor my family's health because of something I brought home from school. Anything regarding the safety of my family is nonnegotiable. So, I have a lot to think about for the next school year or perhaps during Spring Break. I had enough of the fighting just to get a decent wage and to put precautions in place</p>

	<p>for the safety of employees. Teachers and other have simply asked for common sense respect! Yet we hear every time how much we are appreciated ! Keep the words... Show it! \$25.... Really?!!! Thank you CTA for all of your hard work. I still think we deserve more considering all the hard work we do every day and admin continues to pile it on. I work 20-25 extra hours a week on school stuff... for free. I was told, it's expected and it comes with the job. I guess to say, deal with it! What a shame! I have associates that have a HS diploma or a GED making more than me, \$60,000+ as pharmacy techs, not as a pharmacist, but as techs with an HS diploma! No disrespect to that profession... I am happy for them. But I mention that to show how we are so under paid in this profession and I don't feel appreciate it. The district members, administration have NEVER done what teachers are doing now - teaching in a pandemic. I invite each and every one of them to come out of their office and walk in my shoes for a day. Perhaps then they will see what teachers have to go through every day.</p> <p>Speaking of health and safety... my room has not been sanitized in months. I have to clean my room just about every morning. That's all I am going to say about that. Thank you!</p> <p>Please note that I mean no disrespect in my expression to anyone.</p>
Ocoee High	Kids NEED to be in school, they know this now, we've been saying this all along. but my side was shouted down..... If we go "remote" again, I will quit! Remote does not work!
Ocoee High School	I do it because it is important for my students, but have felt no external pressure from the administration or district.
Ocoee High School	<p>I teach at a digital school; nothing has changed concerning my lessons.</p> <p>I don't know much about the sub shortage, below, but i have seen neighbors with notes posted for students to go to the gym. So my guess is an estimation but it could be lower or higher.</p>
Ocoee High School	My admin has made it clear to parents there is no online option at the school level

Ocoee Middle	A lot of parents are not going through proper channels to report Covid cases. Therefore, the number of cases are being underreported.
Olympia H.S.	<p>Classrooms are not sanitized. The custodians do not sweep all classrooms every day. If you say something custodian staff comes to your classroom with an attitude or they get transferred to another building. Conclusion: Your classroom still dirty and not sanitized.</p> <p>Bathrooms floors are not swept daily. Many times there is no soap.</p>
Orange Center Elementary	I was quarantined but had to use my sick leave. this took a great deal of my sick leave hours.
Palmetto Elementary School	<p>Classes are not cleaned and there is a shortage of custodians.</p> <p>*Trash pickup only*</p>
Pershing K8	We have to upload lessons to Canvas or send them by email.
Pershing School K-8	We are being pressured to put stuff on canvas for students who are out.
Pinar ES	Overwhelmed and stressed about working WITH positive students. Why did they even

	do class quarantines last year if this year the positive ones can come to school?
Pineloch Elementary School	Several students have been absent, parents have indicated they called the school's front office to let them know that their child or someone in their household tested positive. They have left messages and these calls were not returned. I do not know if there is a reason for this, I just know my parents have said this to me.
Pinewood Elementary	Critical shortage with custodians and school not being thoroughly cleaned at all. Admin does ALL they can. District states they have coverage for absent custodians which is absolutely NOT true!
Roberto Clemente	I contacted COVID during Christmas break and I informed my principal and they paid for my first 5 days and this week I'm taking sick days on my own. I wished they had told me to bring back a negative test so I could go back but they told me I could go back after 5 days while I still had COVID. I decided not go to work because I didn't want to give anyone COVID.
Roberto Clemente	My Principal is doing the absolute best she can. She is not getting support from the district. The district is too concerned about micromanaging and using the pandemic as an excuse to make our school a correct action school. They sent district people to walk classrooms the day we got back from winter break. They put no effort or concern into student or staff safety.
Robinswood Middle School	I am a teacher by position but since the beginning of the year I have been covering classes that were without a teacher and/or a teacher being absent. We still have classes without teachers from the beginning of the year.
Rock Springs	I provide online content to my students because of the constant risk of quarantine and having my pay cut due to a low VAM score. It is an extra burden on top of an already stressful year.
Sadler	The children are very close together all day long. There is not a way to stay apart from each other as rooms don't allow it for 19 kids and 2 teachers.

SCMS	When I take half day off to go to a doctor. There is no one who can cover my classes. They make me stay.
South Creek Middle School	My room is extremely dirty. I do what I can and I the students assist too. The floor has only been mopped twice this year. Nothing is wiped down I try but it is a lot to teach and wipe down all day every day.
South East Learning Community	We are mandated to attend meetings where some individuals were not wearing masks until it was recently required again.
South Learning Community	We are encouraged to offer "grace" to students but it's gotten out of hands. Took the kids exactly half a second to figure out they could stay home and submit work on Canvas. It's a mess.
SunRidge ES	Our admin has been good about letting teachers decide if we want to send packets or online materials for quarantined students. We have never been asked to provide online instruction.
Sunridge Middle	since the return to school on 1/4, when OCPS told parents they could keep their students home, I have felt pressured to put as much work online as possible.
SunRidge Middle	Students in my class were testing positive and I only received the general school wide announcement. I only found out that it was my students when the students emailed me directly about their positive tests.
Sunset Park	I would like to see everyone move away from the fear and start trying to live a more normal life. This constant state of fear and negativity it not healthy.
SWLC schools	Mandatory in-person meetings where people are shoulder to shoulder in conference rooms with people wearing cloth masks and/or not covering mouth and nose (etc) has been very stressful this year. I have had multiple close contact exposures and never once contacted by DOH or any administrator.
TCHS	Sometimes by parents
Thornebrooke	I have not gotten Covid. The student absences are ridiculous and students are missing valuable instruction that I am being evaluated on when they take FSA.

Tildenville	No cleaning process in the classrooms.
Tildenville Elementary	Our administrator has been very supportive and has left it up to us the teachers to send work home or not.
Timber Creek High School	This suggestion was made one time near the beginning of the year.
Ventura Elementary School	I just tested positive yesterday evening, and am trying to contact my admin for details on sick leave and plans.
Walker Middle school	The district's main focus is making sure students are making learning gains at all costs. They seem to want to hold schools accountable for low performance instead of the students well being in a time that is unprecedented. This is putting undue stress on teachers and school administration
Water Spring ES	My school administrators are amazing. The district seems to not care at all.
Wekiva High School	It was shared with teachers that students who stay home are responsible for keeping up or catching up on work. Admin was very supportive to teachers in not giving more responsibilities.

Westbrooke Elementary	<p>I feel that making me wear a mask, after being vaccinated and getting Covid, is unnecessary. I have had Covid twice now. I can't get it anytime soon and the probability of passing it on to someone else is statistically insignificant.</p> <p>I would like to make my own health decisions on what kind of protection I need. I am an adult.</p> <p>I started to show symptoms on Saturday, December 18th. I tested positive 4 days later. I never had to take off of work, due to my illness happening over winter break.</p> <p>At least 4 students tested positive the last 6 days of school in my classroom alone. Those are the cases that I know about, before we left for winter break.</p>
Westpointe Elementary	I've had to create lesson plans and gather work for a class that is not mine while the teacher was quarantined
Wheatley	I am required to put a packet together for students that do not attend
Whispering oak elementary	I was called by attendance clerk to let me know that one of my students was able to come off the DOH quarantine list. It was shocking because the 4 yr old student had not missed any school. Parent didn't tell me anything. No way for teacher to know if a student is on DOH quarantine list .
Windermere High School	I feel pressured about not failing students even though many are not turning in work with the excuse of staying home. Even before the holiday break, the administration is very demanding about having D's and F's in the class. This year has been rough due to the effects of last year's struggles with hybrid learning. Students and parents are taking advantage, yet AICE and AP courses are

	able to demand more from students than Honors courses.
Windermere High School	The masks should be optional!!!!!!!!!!!!
Windermere HS	Students staying home has been a huge hindrance to student learning. Most students and parents did not contact the school and they have had no contact with teachers.
Windy Ridge	I am super frustrated that students will be sent home because of exposure to other COVID positive students in my classroom but I am not sent home even after being exposed to the same student.
Windy Ridge	Some of these questions should have I don't know as an answer. How would I know if positive cases weren't reported when they never list the names? We wouldn't be having near the problems we have if everyone (students included) on campus wore a mask over their noses. That's like saying people who want to pee on one side of the swimming pool won't affect the other side.
Windy Ridge	Our site is doing the opposite of taking safety measures this year. They have purposely made matters worse. They doubled up approximately 20 different classes on purpose. This did not need to happen, but our administrators just decided to try something different this year. They have 38 elementary kids in a classroom. Just because we have no teacher shortages. They are doing this in art, music, MS electives, etc. Again..... we have never had to do this before. We have plenty of teachers.
Winter Park High	Administration gives no guidance whatsoever.
Winter Park High School Main Campus	No, but others at my site do. I do not because I am an AR and my administrator is also one of the better ones on campus, so no one has pressured me directly. The Science and ESE department AP has pressured her department.
Winter Park High School	My administration is OVERLY concerned about whether students have cell phones, ear buds, or hoodies on in class. One time last week the principal even announced the

	<p>number of times he saw students with a cell phone during class (even sitting on the desk unused is considered with a cell phone). His extreme interest in enforcing the cell phone policy often results in class disruptions when he walks through with the singular purpose of enforcing this rule. The enforcement of this rule seems to even take precedence over COVID protocols. Faculty are to the point where they're complaining to the FAC because the issue is hyper-inflated as a problem. Teachers are more stressed over cell phone walk through a by asking than anything else. There's no interest in the quality of teaching...just whether there's a visible presence of a phone. He even discusses the issue with substitutes who then don't want to work at the school because they're worried they will be targeted despite doing their job to the best of their abilities.</p>

Also "individuals in close proximity have already been contacted" my unvaxed teammate was positive, at PLC that afternoon maskless eating yogurt. None of the other 9 of us was contacted despite close proximity.</p>
	<p>Although my sick leave was covered it is very confusing of what the policy is. You hear a lot of different things. I was covered when my positive test was returned and I'm thankful for</p>

	that since I am almost out of sick leave due to sick children if my own and daycare closure.
	Classrooms aren't being wiped down. The only thing getting taken care of is the trash. It's a struggle to ask for additional sanitizing wipes for classrooms since I have no choice but to wipe it down. We're being told 12-15 minutes of small group time but I'm ESE, so we're the exception expected to do a half hour? The school feels dirty, it doesn't feel safe. Students are being sent back to classrooms and/or having mom bring up cough medicine - not taking symptoms seriously.
	I am not asked to provide videos, but I am asked to put everything in a digital format, which would require extra work in my science classroom that would go beyond contract hours.
	I currently have Covid right now. I believe I contracted it from having other teachers students in my class that also had Covid so I had roughly 2 classes in my classroom because so many people are out.
	I feel pressure from students and parents to do so.
	I have been told when to return to school, but that is not contingent on a negative test result. I will not return to work if I am still positive for Covid.
	I truly believe that all of the COVID issues are beyond my administrator's control. The principal is doing all that she can do and following every step giving by district and CDC guidelines.
	My issue was I was sent an emdd as I'll that I was exposed but principal put in wrong number and I was sent an email that I was exposed.
	One of my students tested positive and had to be rushed off campus. He had been in school all week. I asked the AP what I should do. He said monitor. I asked if I needed a test because I've been with the student. He said no, because I would test negative. (Not true, it could only be a false negative) He also said that unless I was inside of 6 feet for more than 15 minutes with the kid, I wouldn't probably get it. (I thought that was for delta or earlier variants, but this one is more

	<p>transmissible so.....???) I said that it could still get through the mask since it's more transmissible, gesturing to the holes in the sides that cloth masks and some lesser masks have. I said the classroom is enclosed with circulating air. HE LAUGHED AT ME. He reiterated the 6ft 15 min thing, tried to tell me the air is not recirculating, then said "that's why people don't get sick on airplanes". What?!?!..... He completely dismissed my concerns and made me feel like a fool with his condescending tone. He made me feel like my feelings and concerns were not valid and that all he cared about was making sure I was at school, a warm body in a room.</p>
	<p>Our rooms are hardly clean by normal standards, it is a disgrace for a pandemic.</p>
	<p>Our school is not reporting cases.</p>
	<p>-Send home work packets. And it is not explained how much time that can take to parents when promised by other parties than the teacher</p>
	<p>To my knowledge, I haven't had a positive case in my room. However I think it's very irresponsible that students have a positive case at home and can come to school without a mask and potentially infect the whole class. In more than one insistence, a kid has come to school with a positive case at home just to get sick days later.</p>
	<p>We are averaging 20 students in our first grade classrooms. In a year of COVID, we should definitely have smaller classrooms sizes!!!</p>

	<p>We are required to post all assignments so that the assignment can be completed remotely. I had revise my assignments from paper to digital. This takes a tremendous amount of time. We are essentially teaching hybrid classes again but OCPS not calling it that. OCPS just says students can stay home but we have to provide assignments for them to do via Canvas. This is hybrid teaching. Workload is like teaching 2 classes-one in person and one virtually. I am retiring early this month. When I started the year, I had plans to work a couple more years. This year is so bad I am officially retiring in January. I do not feel OCPS has provided a safe work environment during the pandemic and the workload is overwhelming.</p>
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
