Glenridge Middle School	I am concerned about my health, but the biggest safety concern is the increase in student violence. I helped, after school, with a series of student incidents two weeks before Winter Break. No, it wasn't my job, but the bus students were held in the lunch room, and were getting out of control because of a handful of violent students. I watched one of these students wail on my

	Assistant Principal, and she was back on campus before Christmas break. The county is creating an unsafe environment for teachers when they allow these students to return (and not be forced into another school at least for a year.) When other students see students return who have been violent, especially with an adult on campus, they feel emboldened to do the same thing. Many of our teachers have talked about their discomfort, and how they feel that we should collectively give an ultimatum that these students not be allowed to return (or we will not return). The discipline "plan" of the current leadership is nonexistent, and clearly not working. I feel like the environment is unsafe for my well-behaved students and the other adults on campus.
Glenridge MS	We do not have enough staff to monitor the students. Procedures put into place are not followed with the smallest of issues. There are some severe behavior issues with a few students and there is little to no support when dealing with these issues. Teachers feel unsafe and anxious. We need more support!
Glenridge Middle School	As safe as I do anywhere else I have to go. N95 masks required for all. Better technology so we can use technology to allow kids and teachers to be at home.

If I call out now last minute sick in the morning I am “required” to provide doctors note for missed day. So I am forced to go to the doctors now every time I miss work NOT paid and sick to then be forced to go to the doctors to SPEND money cause I have co-pays just to get a note from the doctors as proof that I was sick.

When I tested positive for covid admin assumed I was still reporting to work assuming I had no symptoms. Hospital told me to quarantine for 10 days specially with my underlying health conditions that will make it difficult to recover (yes I’m fully vaccinated) DOH had notified admin of my quarantine days being 10 days. They emailed me telling me they were notified of the 10 days. The cdc changed the quarantine days a couple of days after my diagnosis to 5 days. Subs had already been scheduled, admin had been notified of return dates ect. By DOH and myself and all of asusten on day 5 I was being emailed and texted by admin of my return to work the next day since cdc had changed/updated guidelines for quarantine recently AND after my diagnosis so. That I was cleared to come to work if I had no symptoms or a negative test result. Due to my underlaying health conditions as previously notified to admin recovery for me will be longer and more difficult AND I fell under the previous cdc guidelines. I informed admin that I was still having symptoms and fever with low oxygen. 2 days later I am getting an email from admin again stating that I am failing to meet my professional obligations and asking for my return to work and that I wasn’t going to get paid since the guidelines for quarantine had changed/updated recently regardless of what my original orders were by doctors and DOH. And that for me to return to work u would need a doctors note stating my medical needs for my absences since they are not covered by COVID.

Teachers and myself included are scared to

	call out now, reporting to work sick and all and keeping COVID positive results to themselves for fear of losing our jobs or being harassed to stay at work sick or for an early return to work while still sick. This makes me feel unsafe knowing that teachers health AND LIVES are not a concern, priority,

This is why cases increase because people become lackadaisical and let their guards down. Many students don't take it seriously because they don't see consistency across the board. That student could have infected many classmates throughout the day because they were not taking it seriously, they don't take the proper mask precautions and they get sent back to class and back to school after complaining about feeling sick. Yet, I still don't know if this a coincidence or if the student was actually sick. I think they were sick, but ai wouldn't know because no one has informed me. I have a family to protect. How is it we care more about the well being of these kids than the adults who "make decisions"? I'll tell you why, because "those adults" are in their cushy environments and don't have to deal with what we deal
