

ORANGE COUNTY CTA 2022 ELECTION Runoff Update <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u>

Q When will I receive a ballot?

A Ballots will be mailed, with instructions and a pre-paid postage return envelope, on Thursday, April 7, 2022.

Q Why are we having another election?

A Officer Elections require a majority. That was not reached in the presidential race so we must have this runoff.

Q What is the voting deadline?

A As stated in the instructions, ballots must be in the P.O. Box no later than 1:00 pm on Wednesday, April 27, 2022. They may be sent in by mail in the pre-paid return envelope. Ballots will be counted beginning at 2:00 pm on April 27, 2022 at Orange County Supervisor of Elections as previously announced.

Q Who can vote?

A To vote in the CTA Election, an individual must be a dues-paying member in good standing as of February 3, 2022.

Q What if I did not get my ballot in the mail or if my ballot/return envelope is spoiled?

A If you did not receive a ballot or your ballot/return envelope is spoiled, you may pick up a ballot at the CTA Office during regular business hours which are Mon. – Fri. 7:30 am 6:00 pm. If you pick up a ballot from the CTA Office, you will need to sign a form indicating that you picked up a ballot. If your ballot is spoiled, bring that ballot with you to the CTA Office to exchange it for a new ballot. Remember, if you pick up a replacement ballot, it must still be mailed in time to be in the P.O. Box by no later than 1:00 pm on Wednesday, April 27, 2022.

Q What if I am on a 'protected' mailing list and the RBELC is my mailing address? (This applies to spouses of law enforcement personnel, etc.).

A You may pick up a ballot at the CTA Office during regular business hours which are Mon. – Fri. 7:30 am-6:00 pm. If you pick up a ballot from the CTA Office, you will need to sign a form indicating that you picked up a ballot. Remember, if you pick up a ballot, it must still be mailed in time to be in the P.O. Box by no later than 1:00 pm on Wednesday, April 27, 2022.

Q What is the address of the CTA Office?

Q How do I send in my ballot?

A You must mail your ballot using the pre-paid return envelope provided to the P.O. Box address but be sure to allow time for the U.S. Postal Service to deliver it by no later than 1:00 pm on Wednesday, April 27, 2022. You must write your employee number, name and home address on the return envelope as the return address so CTA membership can be verified. If there are multiple family members living at the same address, each person should use their own envelope to return their ballot.

Q How does CTA verify that a voter is eligible to cast a ballot?

A The following process is in place to ensure voter eligibility:

- The CTA member's employee number will be verified against a list of all CTA eligible member voters.
- You must write your employee number, name and home address on the return envelope as the return address so CTA membership can be verified.

Q Who will count the votes?

A The Orange County Supervisor of Elections will be counting the ballots.

Q Where will the ballots be counted, and who can observe the count?

A The meeting will be held at the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office, 119 West Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida 32806, beginning at 2:00 pm. The meeting is open to the candidate(s) or their designated observer.

Q When will the final election vote count be announced?

A Results will be announced at the conclusion of voting on April 27, 2022 and posted on the CTA Website within 2 working days.
