Visual and/or Performing Arts Sponsor Supplement

Labor Relations wishes to provide some guidance regarding the Visual and/or Performing Arts Sponsor Supplement. This guidance is meant to provide additional information not contained within the Supplement Handbook.

This supplement is designed for those teachers who perform extra duties related to their visual arts/guitar/theatre/dance/piano instructional activities. Some examples of extra duties include art show preparation, community art exhibit set up/take down such as Winter Park Art Show/Maitland Arts Festival, dance choreography, costume preparation, after school rehearsals, instrument repair, evening concerts or recitals, and weekend performances. This supplement is not for running an art club or other before/after school clubs, there is a separate supplement for club sponsors. For the 2022-23 school year, the supplement amounts are \$510 for elementary and \$906 for both middle and high schools. There is not a limit to the number of supplements for a school, every teacher who performs extra duties related to the arts should receive this supplement. All schools received funding in the budget model for this supplement.

Please Note: This supplement does not apply to Band, Chorus, or Orchestra teachers as these teachers receive a separate supplement specific to these positions.
