

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING #9**  
**Adjustment of Full Wednesday Relief for May 3, 2023**  
**November 3, 2022**

As a result of school closures due to Hurricane Ian, the schedule was established for the make-up of lost instructional minutes. This schedule includes seven (7) extended Wednesdays. The last Wednesday is May 10, 2023. The District previously scheduled an extended Wednesday for May 3, 2023, due to testing.

Article XV.C. states:

If a full Wednesday student day is required during the weeks of standardized student testing that increases student contact time, then the workday shall mirror the traditional Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday schedule for students and employees. **On the following Wednesday when testing has ended, all teachers shall be permitted to leave at the end of the scheduled student day.** There shall be no mandatory professional development or required administrative meetings for teachers on that Wednesday. If two Wednesdays are required back to back, teachers shall be allowed to leave at the end of the scheduled student day on the following back to back Wednesdays. Other arrangements may be made between a teacher and the administrator with mutual consent. [Emphasis added]

Due to the May 10, 2023, extension for the make-up of instructional minutes lost during Hurricane Ian, the parties agree to an adjustment of the above contract provision to allow teachers to leave with students on Wednesday, May 17, 2023.

This MOU expires June 30, 2023.
