Approval of Minutes President's Report

- Bargaining Update
 - The president expressed that members helping with bargaining has been excellent.
 - The president highlighted the differences between the district and OCCTA proposals.
 - The president provided other ways members can get involved and support the bargaining process.
- eDues Update
 - 67% of membership has completely transferred to eDues, 33% have not switched over, which means as of September 15th their membership will be revoked.
- Membership Update
 - ARs will receive updated membership list per school as well as eDues update for each site.
 - There is now a new membership form for potential members to join the union, entitled the "FAST TRACK FORM".
 - Membership density is 58%, 13682 is the bargaining unit, and the membership number is 7,896 members. The real density is around 39%
 - The membership will be the same as it was from the Spring.
- Other
 - Newsletters, there are three newsletters, one being for the entire bargaining unit, the others for members only.
 - President highlighted special events such as the next social and the
 - President Clinton mentioned about the AR trainings, all ARs are to attend at least one training. Each school site needs a site leadership team.
 - Annual OCCTA membership meeting on 08/07/23 and 08/15/23 .
