- CTA reserves the right to display the work on its website and future contest materials.
- All art media is allowed as each entry is being submitted digitally.
- One submission per student.
- Be sure to take a high quality photo of the artwork with good lighting so the judges can fully appreciate your effort and creativity.
- Name the file with the student's name, school and grade level. Example: `firstname.lastname.school.gradelevel`
