
Dear Members,

Four in Five educators say CTA should reject the district's proposal to increase health care costs by 64% on average, while 83% report that the proposed increases will have a negative impact on them and their families.


4 in 5 Educators Say CTA Should <u>Reject</u> the District's Proposal to Increase Healthcare Costs by 64% on Average
